13 DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND HISTORY INCLUDING CONSTRUCTION DATE(S), PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS, MATERIALS, MAJOR ALTERATIONS, EXISTANT EQUIPMENT, AND IMPORTANT BUILDERS, ARCHITECTS, ENGINEERS, ETC.

Avery J. and Julia Singer constructed the Employees/Boys Dorm building around 1918, making it one of the earliest built structures at Singer's Lake Crescent Tavern. Presumably, it was constructed to house seasonal employees working at the resort. Since 1951 the building has received substantial alterations: exterior walls have been resided; and an elongated ell entryway has been added to the west wall. In terms of scale, materials, and general design, the Employees/Boys Dorm is compatible with the Singer's Lake Crescent building ensemble.

Rectangular in shape with square addition on north elevation; measures 34' x 14' with 13' x 8' addition; 1 story; wood-frame wall construction with channel drop siding, interspersed with panels of vertical board siding where, perhaps, two doors were once located; gabled roof with composition rolled roofing material; foundation basically post and pier, except on north elevation; horizontally placed logs with diameters of 10' support the cabin. Four-light, horizontal, sliding casement windows; vertical board door with "Z" bracing. Boardwalk leads to cabin. Alterations: addition on north elevation; replacement of sections of siding; possibly moved from original site. Siting: located in wooded area; part of the Singer's Tavern building ensemble.

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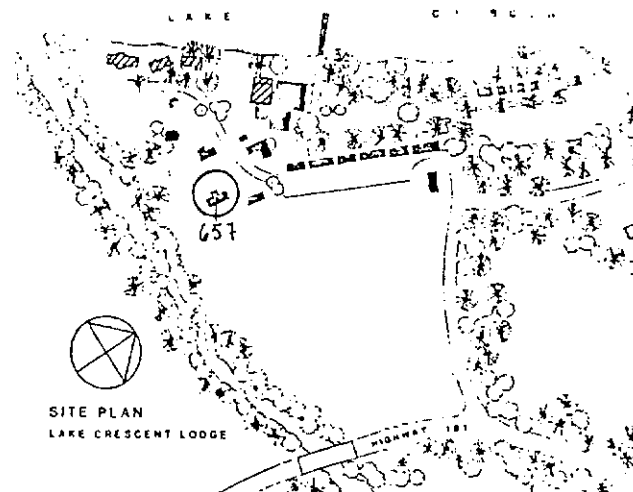
