13. DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND HISTORY INCLUDING CONSTRUCTION DATE(S), PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS, MATERIALS, MAJOR ALTERATIONS, EXISTANT EQUIPMENT, AND IMPORTANT BUILDERS, ARCHITECTS, ENGINEERS, ETC.

This building is reportedly built in 1930, however, there is little evidence to document its existence before the 1950s. Photographic and written data suggest that the building was created from two already existing buildings (an open-sided woodshed and a shed roof enclosed light plant shed), that may have both dated from the 1930s. Such an alteration would have involved the enclosure of the woodshed and the moving of the light plant shed to the side of the woodshed. In terms of scale, design, and materials, the building is presently compatible with the Singer's Lake Crescent Tavern building ensemble.

Rectangular in shape; measures approx. 14' x 20'; 1 story; wood-frame wall construction with wood shingle siding; gable roof with exposed rafters and sheathed with wood shingles; gable roof porch, supported by braces, projects from main (north) facade; concrete slab foundation; horizontal single-light windows in gable ends; wood door with single glass pane in upper portion. Alterations: possibly moved; new foundation; new roofing (1982). Siting: at the edge of forest near small creek; small shake-clad building 1' from west wall; near other storage and employee quarters buildings; part of the Singer's Tavern Group.

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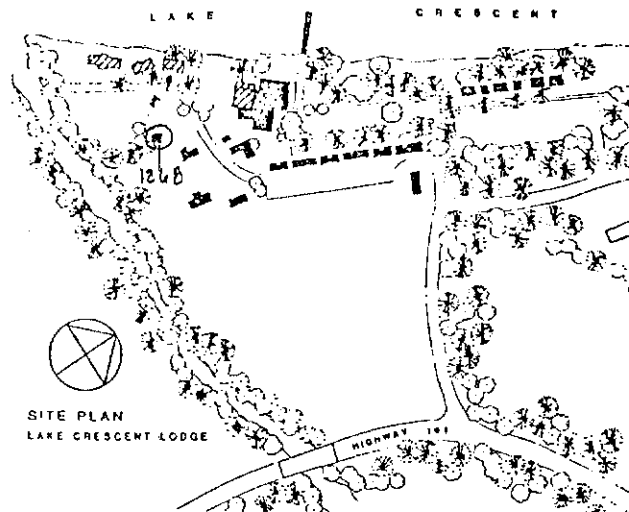
