HELP US KEEP THE MEMORY

On December 7, 1941, 2,390 military and civilian men, women, and children lost their lives in the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, an event that launched the United States into World War II.

In 1962, a private/public campaign raised over \$500,000 and built the first permanent memorial in Pearl Harbor over the sunken battleship USS *Arizona* to honor the 1,177 sailors and marines who lost their lives on the USS *Arizona*. In its first year of operation, 178,000 people visited the USS *Arizona* Memorial.

Today, the Arizona Memorial Museum and Visitor Center is one of the most heavily visited sites in Hawaii with over 1.5 million visitors each year...more than twice as many as it was originally designed to accommodate. As a result, thousands of visitors often stand in line for hours to see this National Historic Landmark during peak seasons. Despite the National Park Service's best efforts, on some days, over 1,500 visitors can not be accommodated at all of the venues and their visit is incomplete.

Memorial Museum and Visitor Center

In 2003, a vision was born to create a new museum and visitor center. This innovative, state-of-the-art facility will be able to accommodate the thousands of visitors daily who seek a deeper understanding of the events that ignited World War II, while sharing and interpreting a wealth of historically important memorabilia.
