USS *Arizona* Memorial & Museum



The USS *Arizona* Memorial National Park and Museum is a historical cultural site, the place where World War II began, with the attack on Pearl Harbor, December 7, 1941. Experience living history as you travel through the Park's many interpretive exhibits including a historical museum, and a tour to the USS *Arizona* – the final resting place for most of the ship's 1,177 crewmen who lost their lives on that fatal day.

Free Daily Tours

provided by the National Park Service
and U.S. Navy

The National Park Service offers a free 75-minute guided tour, which includes a 23-minute documentary film depicting the Pearl Harbor attack, a short boat trip and a self-guided exploration of the USS *Arizona* Memorial. Visitors can receive free tickets for this tour at the visitor center information desk. No reservations are accepted.

In order to visit the many self-guided exhibits located throughout this 10.5 acre historic site, allow at least 2 hours for your visit.

The Museum: A haunting photo of the ship's band the night before the attack...letters written to folks back home...telegrams of condolence...fragments of Japanese war planes and much more tell a tale of life and death, honor, bravery, and unspeakable loss.



Museum Shop: Take home a reminder of the rich history of this place with a visit to the Museum Shop. Proceeds help sustain the operation of the USS *Arizona* Memorial and Museum.

The Memorial: A short boat trip will take you through Pearl Harbor to the actual resting place of the men who lost their lives on the USS *Arizona*. The Memorial stands as a reminder of this "Day of Infamy" – the worst naval disaster in American history.



Waterfront Exhibits: A self-guided tour along the waterfront promenade, allows you to visualize the actual events of December 7, 1941.
