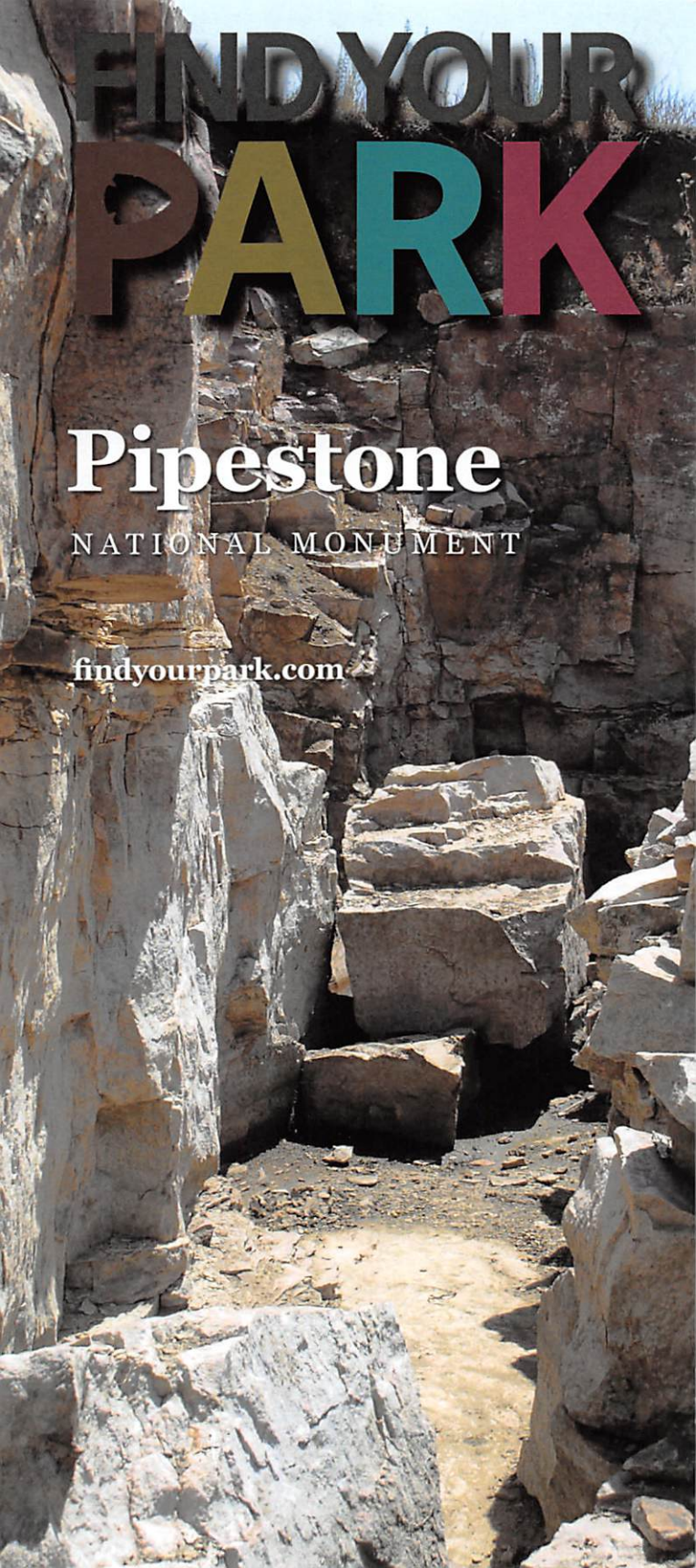

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What does Pipestone National Monument have to offer?

Sacred Pipestone quarries, Tallgrass prairie, Winnewissa Waterfall, Petroglyphs, a 3/4-mile trail which routes along the quarries, prairie, creek and waterfall, visitor center and museum, Pipestone carving demonstrators (May through October), 22-minute award-winning documentary, Pipestone Indian Shrine Association bookstore and gift shop, and a Junior Ranger program for kids.

Visitor Center hours are 8:30 am to 5:00 pm daily.

Closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Years Day
