**public use of the national parks;
a statistical report**

1954 - 1964

FOREWORD

The National Park Service, a bureau of the Department of the Interior, administers Federally owned scenic, scientific, historic, and recreational areas established by statutory authority for the benefit and enjoyment of the people, and the National Capital Parks, a metropolitan park system comprising over 750 urban and rural parks located in and around Washington, D. C. exclusive of the National Memorials located there.

The data tabulated here exhibit the annual volumes of public use of the administered areas covering the years 1954 through 1964. This continues the series of such summaries, the first of which covered the period 1904-1940 and the second 1941-1953. Although the content and manner of presentation of the statistics in the current summary are largely consistent with those issued previously, a few differences justify some special remarks.

The statistical unit in which public use data are currently produced is the "Visit", by which is meant the entry of any person into an area administered by the National Park Service such that he makes some use of the services or facilities provided therein by the Service. A few parks are excluded from the reporting system for reasons of impracticality in producing consistent or meaningful data.

The above definition of the "Visit" unit became effective in 1960. Prior to that time, the statistical unit was more analogous to what might be called "bonafide visitor", by which was roughly intended the entry of a person into a park intent on pursuing the type of recreation, educational, or allied activities for which the park in question was established. During the pre-1960 period attempts were made, with varying degrees of success, to eliminate both non-conforming (for example, non-recreational) use from the data and also to remove re-entries from the data, (that is, visitors who made more than one entry into a park during a brief period of time). The new definition was adopted in 1960 because of the practicable impossibility of both accurately and efficiently making the delineations and adjustments required on a consistent and continuing basis throughout the National Park Service.

Thus, for a number of parks there are marked discontinuities in the series of historical data between 1959 and 1960. In the tables, the presence of these discontinuities is emphasized with an extra-wide spacing between the columns of data for those two years. The public use data for all parks were not affected by the

change in definition. Those whose series exhibit a discontinuity are: Acadia, Crater Lake, Great Smoky Mountains, Hot Springs, Mount Rainier, and Wind Cave National Parks; Colorado, Effigy Mounds, El Morro, Glacier Bay, Montezuma Castle, and Pipestone National Monuments; Colonial, and Morristown National Historical Parks; Chickamauga and Chattanooga, Fort Donelson, Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania, Gettysburg, Guilford Courthouse, Kings Mountain, Moores Creek, and Vicksburg National Military Parks; Richmond National Battlefield Park; Petersburg National Battlefield; and Coulee Dam, Lake Mead, and Shadow Mountain National Recreation Areas. Changes in the statistical series for the above areas also affected the totals for the administrative regions and Service as a whole. With respect to the latter, the effect of the changed definition of the reported statistic was to raise the numerical total about 12% from what would otherwise have been reported.

Individual series since 1960 may exhibit an occasional apparent discontinuity. This arises from an ongoing process of revisions in "Visit" estimating procedures which grow out of changes in access or internal circulation roads, or development of new facilities.

Among the attached tables the summary by type of area, (previously published), has been replaced by the more useful summary by geographic-administrative region. Inside the front cover of this report will be found a map showing the location of the individual areas and the boundaries of the administrative regions.

Statistics on the public use of the National Parks, including series on both visits and overnight stays in the parks, are published monthly. For those wishing to study recreation and park use in detail, back numbers of the monthly compilations are available on request until the stock is exhausted. While printed in limited numbers, complete annual sets are usually available for the current year and the immediately preceding bi-ennium.

The figures in Tables 2-5 are shown in thousands of visits.
