Friends of the Park are helping with a project focused on Rocky Mountain's future.

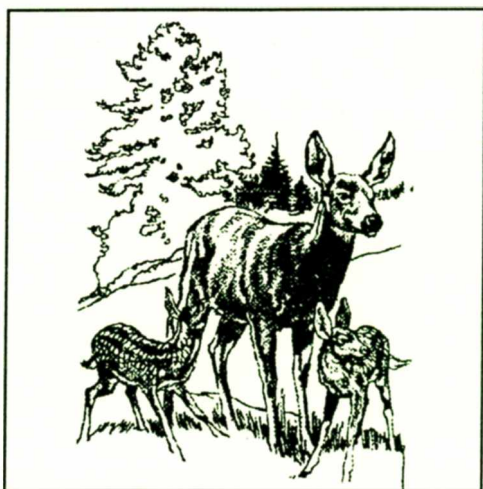
The Fall River Visitor Center, planned for construction along Highway 34 near the Fall River Entrance, will serve nearly a million park visitors each year
