By Car: Milford is located in the northeastern corner of Pennsylvania, along the Delaware River. It is located off of Route 6.

From Southeastern Pennsylvania: (Driving time is 3-3.5 hours) From the Northeast Extension, travel north to Exit 33 (Allentown). From Allentown, take Route 22 east to Route 33 north. Route 33 merges with Route 209 north. Stay on Route 209 to Interstate 80 (Stroudsburg). Head east on I-80 to Route 209-North (Marshall's Creek). Travel north on Route 209 through the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area (posted speed limits: 35 mph; 45 mph). In *Milford*, proceed straight at the traffic light and drive several blocks. Look for the Grey Towers sign at fork in the road. Bear left, the entrance to Grey Towers is up the road on your left.

From Scranton, Pennsylvania: (Driving time is 1 hour) Take Interstate 81 North to Interstates 380/84. Head east on I-84 toward Milford when I-380/84 split. Take Exit 10 and bear right off ramp toward the town of Milford. At the base of the hill, make a sharp right just after the Apple Valley Shops Complex. The entrance drive to Grey Towers is up the road on your left.

From Newark, New Jersey: (Driving time is 1.5-2 hours) When exiting the airport, follow signs to I-78-West. Continue on to 24-West to I-287-North to I-80-West to Routes 15/206 North (Dover/Sparta). Continue north on Route 206 crossing the toll bridge over the Delaware River. Turn right and head into Milford. In *Milford*, proceed straight at the traffic light and drive several blocks. Look for the Grey Towers sign at fork in the road. Bear left, the entrance to Grey Towers is up the road on your left.

From Newburg, NY: (Driving time is 1 hour) Interstate 84 is approximately 3 miles from Stewart Airport. Take I-84-West to Pennsylvania, Exit 10 (Milford). Turn left off ramp toward Milford. At the base of the hill, make a sharp right just after the Apple Valley Shops Complex. The entrance to Grey Towers is up the road on your left.

From New England: (Driving time from Hartford is 3 hours) Take I-84 to Pennsylvania Exit 10

(Milford). Turn left off ramp toward Milford. At the base of the hill, make a sharp right just after the Apple Valley Shops Complex. The entrance to Grey Towers is up the road on your left.

By Plane: The most convenient airport in terms of connections is the Newark (NJ) International Airport. Another alternative is the Scranton/Wilkes Barre Airport in Avoca, PA or Stewart International Airport, Newburg, NY.

By Train: Amtrak to Newark, N.J. from Washington, D.C. or Philadelphia. (Rental cars are available at the train station) When exiting train station, make left at light (Raymond Ave.) at next light, make a right onto McCarter Highway. Travel for about 1 mile and make a right on Harrison Ave. Follow signs to I-280 West. From I-280 West, follow signs to I-80 West (Delaware Water Gap) to Routes 15/206 North (Dover/Sparta). Continue north on Route 206 crossing the toll bridge over the Delaware River. Turn right and head into Milford. In *Milford*, proceed straight at the traffic light and drive several blocks. Look for the Grey Tower sign at fork in the road. Bear left, the entrance to Grey Towers is up the road on your left.
