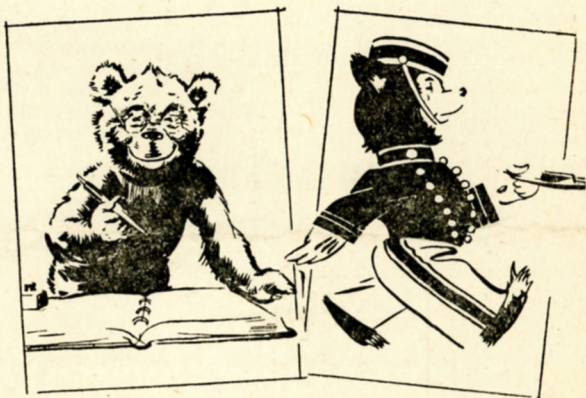

In Yellowstone Park you are offered the greatest possible range in types and prices of accommodations. 1947 season:

HOTELS

June 20 to September 10

LODGES

June 20 to about September 5

TOURIST CABINS and CAFETERIAS

May 10 to about October 10

SPEED LIMIT 45 MILES PER HOUR

Camping

If you have your own tent and equipment with you, you may camp at places designated by the National Park Service, with no charge other than your motor vehicle license fee of \$3.00 which is paid to the Federal Government. House trailers \$1.00 additional. **CAMPING LIMITED TO 30 DAYS IN ANY ONE AREA.**

Tourist Cabins

(Log and Frame Type)

LIMITED TO 5 DAYS AT EACH LOCATION

Partially furnished cabins as described below:

Single cabins equipped with double bedstead, bed spring, mattress, mattress cover, stove, washstand, table, bench, mirror, slop jar, wash basin, pitcher, tea kettle.

One person, per day\$1.25
Two persons, per day 1.50

Double cabins equipped with double bedstead, bed spring, mattress, single bedstead, bed spring, mattress, two mattress covers, stove, washstand, table, two benches, mirror, slop jar, wash basin, pitcher, tea kettle.

Two persons, per day\$1.75
Three persons, per day 2.00

Double cabins equipped with two double bedsteads, two bed springs, two mattresses, two mattress covers, one stove, two washstands, two tables, two benches, two mirrors, one slop jar, wash basin, pitcher, teakettle.

Two persons, per day\$2.00
Three persons, per day 2.25
Four persons, per day 2.50

Canvas and frame cabins with the same equipment [at Old Faithful and Thumb when available] 25c less per day, per cabin.

Each additional person or cot in above cabins 25c per day. Bedding and camping equipment may be rented for a small daily charge.

At Old Faithful and Fishing Bridge, cabins partially equipped similar to the above, but with sinks and running water in kitchens, are available at the following rates:

Two-Room Cabins (Bedroom and Kitchen)

One or two persons, per day\$2.50
Each additional person or cot, per day50

Three-Room Cabins (Two Bedrooms and Kitchen)

Two, three, or four persons, per day\$4.00
Each additional person or cot, per day50

Fully Furnished Cabins

[NOT INCLUDING COOKING UTENSILS]

One person, per night\$2.25
Each additional person 1.50

Padlock and key furnished for log and frame cabins only; 50c deposit required.

Tourist cabins are located at Canyon, Fishing Bridge, Mammoth, Old Faithful, Thumb, and Camp Roosevelt. Meals may be prepared in cabins.

Cafeterias

Located at Canyon, Fishing Bridge, Mammoth, Old Faithful, Thumb. Meals and lunches served at popular prices from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Coffee Shop and Soda Fountains

There is a soda fountain, Coffee Shop, and Grill at Mammoth, and soda fountains at Old Faithful, Lake, Fishing Bridge, Thumb, Tower Falls, Canyon, and at all hotels. Also lunch rooms in general stores at Canyon and Tower Falls.

LODGES

OLD FAITHFUL, LAKE, CANYON LODGES, and CAMP ROOSEVELT

LIMITED TO 5 DAYS AT EACH LOCATION

Lodge cabins are fully equipped with comfortable bed, fresh linen every day, electric light, heating stove, and price includes maid and bell boy service. Every morning a fire will be built in cabin if desired. Entertainment and dances every night but Sunday at Lodges.

Telephone, telegraph, laundry service, beauty, barber shops, soda fountains at above lodges; tap room Old Faithful and Canyon Lodge.

Lodging Only { 1 person in cabin, per day\$2.25
Each additional person, per day 1.50

Coffee Shops with reasonable prices at Old Faithful, Lake, Canyon lodges, and Camp Roosevelt. Cooking not permitted in lodge cabins.

HOTELS

OLD FAITHFUL INN and CANYON HOTEL

LIMITED TO 5 DAYS AT EACH LOCATION

All hotel rooms attractively furnished, steam heated, and have hot and cold running water. Personnel employed is of the highest type.

Barber shop, beauty parlor, buffet, telephone, telegraph, and laundry service at all hotels. Tailor and cleaning service at Canyon Hotel and Old Faithful Inn. Cocktail rooms at all hotels.

MAMMOTH SPRINGS HOTEL and COTTAGES

Room rates at Mammoth Springs Hotel are same as shown just above under "Rates for Rooms Only, Per Night, All Hotels."

Modern cottages, with or without bath, are operated by Mammoth Springs Hotel. They appeal to all visitors, particularly to motorists who make Mammoth Hot Springs headquarters for their Park sight-seeing activities. All cottages completely furnished. Rates per night are:

One-Room Cottage with Shower, Lavatory, and Toilet

1 person\$4.00 2 persons\$6.00 3 persons\$8.00

Two-Room Cottage with Bath Between

2 persons\$7.00 3 persons\$9.00 4 persons\$11.00

One-Room Cottage with Hot and Cold Running Water (Twin Beds)

One-Room Cottage with Hot and Cold Running Water (Double Bed)

1 person\$2.25 2 persons\$4.00

Dining Room—Table d'hote meals served at regular hours.

Terrace Grill and Lunch Room—Popular priced club breakfasts, lunches, dinners, short order service. Open 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m.

Cocktail Room and Soda Fountain—Located in Recreation Building.

Entertainment—Dancing every evening except Sunday in Recreation Building.

Yellowstone Lake

Yellowstone Lake offers the best of trout fishing. Row boats may be rented at Fishing Bridge and Thumb for 65c per hour. Fishing tackle can be rented or purchased at the Boat House offices, Lake and Fishing Bridge stores.

Bathing

There are two swimming pools in the Park, one located at Old Faithful, and the other at Mammoth Hot Springs, both using natural warm water from hot springs. Price of admission to pools is 50c per person, including suit and towel. Children from ages 5 to 12, 25c each. Children under 5 admitted free when accompanied by full pay bathers. Bath house also located at Fishing Bridge auto camp. Tub baths 50c each. Showers, hot or cold, 25c. Laundry trays and electric irons for rent.

Saddle Horses

Saddle horses are available at Mammoth, Old Faithful, and Canyon for many scenic rides and short trips. Cowboy guides in charge of horses will gladly give you full information.

General Stores

General Stores and service stations are located at Mammoth, Old Faithful, Thumb, Lake, Fishing Bridge, Canyon, Camp Roosevelt, and Tower Falls (store only). They handle all visitor needs, including fresh fruit, vegetables, meat, and groceries.

Picture Shops

Picture shops, located at above mentioned points, carry a full line of cameras and film. Guide books, post cards, pictures, and many other souvenirs relating to the Park for sale.

Mail

Main post office at Mammoth. Branches in Old Faithful, Thumb, Lake, Fishing Bridge, and Canyon general stores. Mail addressed to any particular hotel or tourist cabin camp should be called for there.

Telephone and Telegraph Service

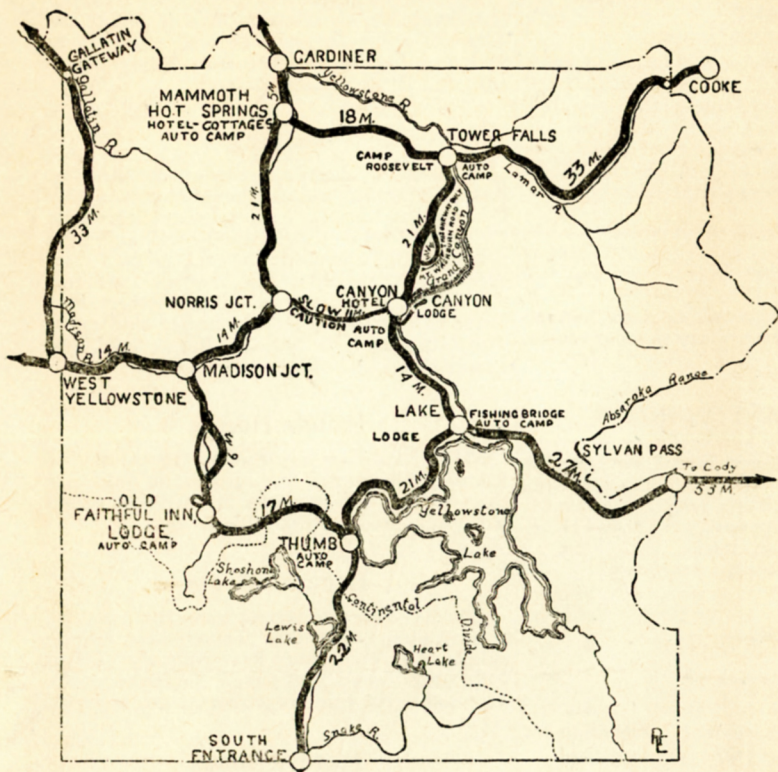
Local and long distance telephone service at hotels lodges, and tourist cabins. Telegraph service at hotels. **BE SURE TO ASK FOR TELEGRAMS AT ANY OF THESE PLACES.**

Medical Service

Hospital maintained at Mammoth Hot Springs is in charge of a competent doctor, and at each hotel, lodge, and at Fishing Bridge tourist cabins, there are trained nurses to take care of any emergency work.

Church Services

Protestant and Catholic services are scheduled for each Sunday during the season at several locations in the Park.

Garages

Located at Mammoth, Old Faithful, Fishing Bridge, and Canyon, can handle all ordinary automobile repairs. Large shops near Gardiner, Montana, handle all heavy work.

The Fire Danger!

Visitors must use the greatest caution in handling matches, cigar and cigarette stubs, and pipe ashes. Extinguish all sparks before throwing them away.

Camp fires must not be built any larger than necessary, nor in leaves or rotten wood where they are likely to spread. Dig holes or clear the ground to confine your fire. Extinguish carefully all sparks upon leaving, even for a short absence.
