DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

- McCauley Barn (cribwork interior) Foresta: (McCauley Ranch). Located in open pasture, adjacent to the old "El Portal Road" (trail), approx. 2½ miles S. of Foresta. This structure is similar in design to the Meyer Barn No. 2 because both have the log crib core for hay storage, with surrounding stalls. The McCauley Barn, which measures roughly 40' x 80', has a gable roof and is built into the hillside. The crib consists of peeled logs laid in alternating tiers and fastened together with a V-notch joint. The logs were not chinked. The deeply overhanging gable roof is supported by peeled log rafters, and while originally covered with wood shingles, is now covered with corrugated metal. The barn is sheathed with vertical board siding. The barn setting retains its historic character has been used for grazing from 1897 to 1975.
- Meyer Barn No. 1 (saltbox shaped) Big Meadow:

This is a gable roofed structure, with a lean-to shed addition, which gives the building the form of a saltbox. The main portion of the barn measures roughly 30' x 20', with the lean-to measuring 30' x 16'. The frame of the barn consists of hand-hewn timbers arranged in five structural bents, with the horizontal beams fastened to the vertical columns by means of iron straps, and braced on each side with a diagonal timber. The frame is sheathed with vertical boards, except for the east facade, where sheathing is missing. The wood shingled roof is supported by peeled log rafters.

• Meyer Barn No. 2 (cribwork interior) - Big Meadow:

This barn is a large structure measuring roughly 50' square, and has a steeply pitched, overhanging gable on hip roof. The core of the structure consists of a rectangular log crib, approximately 25 feet in height, which supports the gable portion of the roof. The crib, which was evidently used for hay storage, is constructed with peeled logs laid on alternating tiers, and joined with a saddle notch joint, with no chinking between the logs. A space of several feet between the logs at one point was provided for pitching the hay into the stalls. The stalls were built on 3 sides of the crib, and the perimeter wall consists of hand-hewn studs and sills. The roof is carried by peeled log rafters. The barn is sheathed with vertical boards, and the original wood shingle roof has been covered with corrugated metal.

The Meyer Barns are located in close proximity to one another (photo #4) near the southwestern boundary of Big Meadow - a large open meadow within Yosemite National Park that comes approx. 1 square mile, (elevation 4500). The Meadow is currently in the process of nomination to the National Register as part of the Foresta-Big Meadow Archeological District. The southern edge of Big Meadow is the location for the largest known prehistoric Sierran habitation site, 4-MRP-3. The site covers several acres and contains more than 400 bedrock mortar ceyes. Its midden may be 6 ft. deep in places. There are 19 other known sites withing the meadow and along its other 3 sides.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

These three barns are the last remaining barns in Yosemite which possess architectural significance and integrity. They also represent some <u>local</u> interest in agriculture through association with pioneering ranches once located on, and within the boundaries of Yosemite National Park.

The barns differ from each other in form and design, but all are largely handcrafted. They are representative of local vernacular building traditions; and are nearly unchanged from their original appearance. Both the Mc Cauley barn and the Meyer barn #2 are examples of an unusual California type known as the "Mormon Pole Barn", more often found in the Genessee Valley and dating from the 1850's.

The Mc Cauley barn was built around 1883 by Irishman James McCauley, pioneer Yosemite trailbuilder and innkeeper: he built the Four Mile trail to Glacier Point in 1871 and the Glacier Point Mountain House in 1878. He was running the Mountain House in 1883 when he purchased the land for his ranch, elevation 4000 ft., for winter headquarters. Glacier Point's 7214 ft. elevation and heavy snow ruled out all-year residence. In 1886 Mc Cauley added 200 acres to his original ranch through two separate purchases—these 200 acres would eventually become the Foresta subdivision. McCauley became a year round resident of the ranch in 1897 when some "political manuveur" (sic) forced him from his Glacier Point enterprise. McCauley then worked the ranch with his son, supplying beef to Valley businesses, until his death in an accident on the old Coulterville Road in 1911. In 1913 his son, Fred, sold the previously mentioned 200 acres to C.P. Snell for \$5500. In 1923 he sold the remainder of the ranch to his cousin, Horace M eyer for \$6000. The property has been unoccupied since 1955 and the National Park Service acquired it in 1974.

George Meyer, a German born ship carpenter, took over his brother Henry's homestead in Big Meadow in the 1870's. The meadow was considerably smaller than its present size before George cut trees and cleared brush. From sketchy biographical material it can be surmised that Meyer barn #2 was built in the late 1870's and #1 in the early 1880's. The walls of the latter barn were supposedly built flat on the ground and then raised in one piece. Meyers ranch was a stage stop on the Old Coulterville Road and he supplied grains and vegetables to Yosemite Valley businesses. In 1900 he married Elizabeth McCauley, niece of his "neighbor" James McCauley and as previously noted, his son Horace added the McCauley holdings to the family property in 1923. George Meyer died in San Francisco in 1917 and was buried in that city.






